SUNJET II (Sustainable Network for Japan-Europe aerospace research and Technology cooperation II) organizes the SUNJET II Forum on “**Europe-Japan Cooperation in the domain of R&T for Aviation**”. The Forum will be held on the 21st of June 2017 during the **International Paris Air Show 2017** at VIPARIS Conference Centre.

The SUNJET II forum aims to:

- Provide the policy-making authorities' perspective on the importance of EU-Japan collaboration in aviation,
- Clearly demonstrate the benefits of working together through a number of presentations of successful EU-Japan common research activities.

The SUNJET II Forum is an excellent opportunity to gather diverse stakeholders from Europe and Japan and to pave the way for future EU-Japan cooperation, which could be co-funded by Horizon 2020 (EU's Framework Programme for Research & Innovation) and by METI (Japan's Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry) and other relevant Japanese Ministries or organizations.

Major representatives of European and Japanese entities including but not limited to: Air-

bus Group, METI, European Commission, Clean Sky, JADC, Rolls-Royce, JAXA, DLR, CIRA, ONERA, SAFRAN, TsAGI, NLR, Compañía Española de Sistemas Aeronáuticos, S.A., PEMAS, EASN Association, Esterline Belgium, GE Aviation Systems, WeAre Aerospace will attend the Forum and have the opportunity to meet and interact with each other.

The experience gained through numerous bilateral collaborations between EU and Japanese entities, but also several co-funded collaborative projects in FP7 and H2020, make it evident that both Europe and Japan have a lot to gain from working together and combining expertise in Aviation related research activities.

SUNJET II, brings together stakeholders from Europe and Japan and aims to create roadmaps in the fields of Airframe, Engine, Systems and Equipment with the support of the Industry, R&T Institutions, Academia and Clusters Communities. Furthermore, SUNJET II acts as a facilitator towards further enhancement of EU-Japan R&T cooperation in Aviation. This is done through the development of openly accessible tools, allowing the creation of new partnerships, the provision of practical advice and best practices for working together and the identification of research topics of mutual interest.
